- Manage the social media calendar
- Brainstormed on campaign ideas
- Analyze analytics to gauge the success of the campaigns.

# Knowledge and experience

Candidates who meet the following criteria would be preferred

- Have a degree in communication, marketing, journalism
- Have experience in developing content for various social media platforms and formats, writing and graphic design.
- Have a creative mindset and able to multitask.
- Have a genuine interest in the fields of genocide and mass atrocity prevention, human rights, peacebuilding and keeping.
- Is self-motivated, resourceful, able to work independently and in a team, respect the time requirements agreed upon with the rest of the team.
